Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board Announces Temporary Relocation of the Fine Wine & Good Spirits Premium Collection Store in Erie

Erie – The Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (PLCB) announced the Fine Wine & Good Spirits Premium Collection Store in Yorktown Centre, 2501 W. 12th St., Erie, will be temporarily relocated while the store is remodeled.

The current store will close at 5:00 P.M. on Sunday, April 10. On April 11, a temporary Fine Wine & Good Spirits Premium Collection Store will open at 2503 W. 15th St., just a short walk south from the store's current location. The temporary store will be open during the same hours as the store being remodeled – Monday through Saturday from 9 A.M. to 10 P.M. and Sunday from noon to 5 P.M.

When it reopens later this year, the remodeled Fine Wine & Good Spirits Premium Collection Store in Erie will offer consumers a warmer, more welcoming atmosphere to browse its extensive collection; a center table featuring a tasting bar, promotional items and educational materials; a "Made in Pennsylvania" section to highlight wines and spirits produced in the commonwealth; and other upgrades.

The PLCB regulates the distribution of beverage alcohol in Pennsylvania, operates more than 600 wine and spirits stores statewide and licenses more than 20,000 beverage alcohol producers and retailers. The PLCB also works to reduce and prevent dangerous and underage drinking through partnerships with schools, community groups and licensees. Taxes and store profits – totaling more than \$14.5 billion since the agency's inception – are returned to Pennsylvania's General Fund, and the PLCB also provides financial support for the Pennsylvania State Police Bureau of Liquor Control Enforcement, the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs, other state agencies and local municipalities across the state.
