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MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

Welcome to the 2012 – 13 Retail Year in Review. In the following pages, you will see a detailed market analysis of wine and spirit sales at the more than 600 Fine Wine & Good Spirits stores in Pennsylvania. The data illustrate consumer tastes and industry trends in the alcohol beverage market, which are used to ensure the PLCB provides the products consumers want in the regions where they live.

The 2012 – 13 retail year was a strong year financially for the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board. We set a record in terms of dollar sales with growth in both wine and spirits. Over the past seven years, wine has continued to increase its share of our total sales volume. However, spirits still account for the majority of sales in Pennsylvania.

Perhaps as a result of a stronger economy and our initiative to provide wine consumers with more assistance and information at our stores, consumers bought more premium, super-premium and ultra-premium wines compared to the last retail year. Overall, the most popular wine categories included U.S. Chardonnay, 5-liter box wine and U.S. Cabernet. White wines, blends and sweet wines also continue to do well with consumers.

Flavored spirits continued to show impressive growth statewide. In the past, flavored vodka led that growth, and while the category still enjoys strong sales, new categories, such as flavored whiskeys and bourbons, are making impressive gains. Overall, like wine consumers, spirits consumers were more willing to spend their money on high-end products this year.

A number of large counties – Bucks, Lancaster, Chester, Allegheny, Westmoreland and Montgomery – had dollar-sales increases of roughly 4 percent, which generated an additional \$33.15 million for the commonwealth. The top 30 Fine Wine & Good Spirits stores statewide accounted for approximately 20 percent of total dollar sales.

The sales mentioned throughout this publication will ultimately benefit the commonwealth through the taxes collected and the monetary transfer to the General Fund. As we plan for the agency's future, we will continue to look for opportunities to provide more convenient access to a variety of products at better prices. We are opening more customer-focused Fine Wine & Good Spirits stores throughout the state, and increasing staff training to meet heightened consumer expectations. It is our hope these efforts will provide consumers with a world-class shopping experience and allow us to continue our impressive growth.

RESEARCH NOTES

The Retail Year in Review 2012 – 13 is a compilation of informative reports on the retail performance of Pennsylvania's Fine Wine & Good Spirits stores. This publication is designed to be educational and user-friendly. Feedback on previous editions has shaped the document's presentation and continuous review of industry trends help to inform the reporting. Data were collected through the point of sales system (POS), stored and then extracted from the data warehouse. The Bureau of Market and Store Analytics coordinated this project.

Various filters were used to extract the data. The report filter for the retail year end date 6/30/2013 was the most common. Due to the type of report, different filters may be used. For example special orders (SO) are not included in all reports. Other reports may use the Gregorian calendar, which starts January 1 and ends December 31, instead of the retail calendar. The changes will be noted throughout.

Calculations in the report include percentage change, the comparison of sales this year against last year. As a note on year-to-year comparisons, the previous retail year 2011 – 12 was a leap year, containing 53 weeks of sales. The 2012 – 2013 retail year contained the normal 52 weeks. Another common measure is percentage share, the proportion a specific item, category or location contributes to an overall sales total. Dollar sales amounts include the standard markup and the emergency tax. Sales tax (6%) or any local taxes, such as those from Allegheny and Philadelphia counties, are not applied.


Please note the data in this report are unaudited and may vary from financial statements. The data may vary from other beverage alcohol industry reports due to calendar date alignments, sorting techniques and filter criteria as well as data normalization.



RETAIL YEAR SALES & SHARES

The broad overview of retail sales in Fine Wine & Good Spirits stores can be captured by sales figures and percentage shares by departments as well as categories. In the most recent year dollar sales were \$1,963,165,381.29, up 3.42% from the past year. Figure 1 displays the dollar sales amount for the past seven retail years. Please note this report includes all sales with the exception of special order (SO) merchandise.

Figure 1: Retail Year Dollar Sales (RY 2006 - 07 to RY 2012 - 13)



Breaking out the amount of wine and spirits sold, there are different sales proportions of each. Table 1 illustrates the dollar sales skew towards spirits (58.17%). Over previous years, spirits have averaged around 60% of the dollar share of sales.

Table 2 displays the percentage share based on units. Again, spirits (50.32%) are the larger share; however the unit share difference is less than the dollar share difference.

Sales by month are displayed in Figure 2¹. The top three months are December (12.62%), November (9.31%) and May (8.69%). Together they generated \$624,062,958 or 30.62% of dollar sales.

RETAIL YEAR SALES & SHARES

Table 3 ranks the top marketing categories by dollar sales. Vodka (\$254,863,618) and Vodka - Flavored (\$111,081,173) are the largest categories in terms of dollar sales. US Chardonnay (\$65,367,020) and 5L Box Wine (\$55,385,880) were the top wine categories.

Market share by category is presented in Table 4. Here the larger spirits categories, Vodka (12.99%), Vodka - Flavored (5.66%), Bourbon (5.42%) and Rum - Spiced (3.49%) top the list. The top wines by share are US Chardonnay (3.33%), 5L Box Wine (2.82%) and US Cabernet (2.78%).

RETAIL YEAR SALES & SHARES

Figure 3 is a line graph of the transactions over the past year². The most transactions occurred in December (7,143,243), followed by November (5,680,785), March (5,370,381) and May (5,353,759). During the calendar year, there were a total of 62,949,658 transactions.

The daily transaction counts are displayed in Figure 4. In terms of sales by day, Friday (14,254,345) and Saturday (13,650,591) are the busiest days³.

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STORE & COUNTY REPORTS

County and store reports provide details on how different areas of the state perform. This section also highlights changes in county level trends and presents the sales of each store⁴.

A summary of dollar sales by category in each county is found in Table 5⁵. Allegheny (\$252,820,413) and Philadelphia (\$222,839,496) are the top counties. Montgomery (\$190,603,986) follows closely with two other southeastern counties Bucks (\$129,877,249) and Chester (\$114,468,919) rounding out the top five counties in dollar sales. These same counties are also the highest sellers of Cordials, Rum, Table Wine, Vodka and Whiskey.

Each county has a profile of what its shoppers purchase. Measuring this can be done by considering what percentage share of dollar sales make up the total for each county. For example, among the top categories, Cordials have a higher percentage share of sales in Cameron (19.68%), Mifflin (18.82%) and Jefferson (16.16%) counties. Rum has a higher percentage share of sales in Northumberland (16.58%), Mifflin (15.43%) and Elk (15.33%). Table Wine has the largest share in Chester (45.61%), Montgomery (44.76%) and Bucks (42.63%). Figure 5 is a visual representation of this data.



Percentage change is a way to consider sales growth at the county level. Table 7 shows the top 20 growth counties based on this measure. Wyoming (7.12%), Bedford (6.77%), Butler (4.89%), Franklin (4.83%) and Bucks (4.73%) had the most growth. These data also indicate there was high sales growth in counties holding a higher share of overall dollars.

Bucks, Chester (4.38%), Allegheny (4.26%) and Montgomery (3.82%) were among those counties with higher growth and these counties also have a larger base of sales and their increase provides proportionately greater dollar value.

The top 100 items, based on units sold are ranked in Table 13. The list for this retail year has 28 products in the Vodka category. The 750 mL size was the most frequent in the top 100, with 45 items in that size⁶.

Captain Morgan Original Spiced Rum 750 mL (1,008,437), Jack Daniel's Black Label Whiskey 750 mL (887,263), Nikolai Vodka 375 mL (845,979), Vladimir Vodka 1.75 L (750,669) and Jägermeister Liqueur 750 mL (694,956) were the top 5 items in terms of unit sales. Kendall-Jackson Vintner's Reserve Chardonnay (#9, 551,781), Sutter Home White Zinfandel (#11, 529,531), Cavit Pinot Grigio (#12, 525,740), Woodbridge Chardonnay (#17, 471,147) and Franzia Sunset Blush (#30, 363,331) were the top wines.

Among the top 3 unit increases⁷ from the previous year were two Flavored Whiskey items, Wild Turkey American Honey Liqueur 750 mL (40.13%) and Fireball Cinnamon Whisky 750 mL (342.90%)⁸. Woodbridge Pinot Grigio 1.5 L (65.67%) and Franzia Chardonnay (37.23%) were among the top percentage increases for wine items.

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Table 14 shows the top 100 items by dollar sales. The list included a total of 29 Vodka items. A total of 39 items were 750 mL and another 34 were 1.75 L. Jack Daniel's Black Label Whiskey 750 mL (\$19,312,166), Captain Morgan Original Spiced Rum 1.75 L (\$18,648,891), Captain Morgan Original Spiced Rum 750 mL (\$15,696,284), Grey Goose Vodka 750 mL (\$14,104,459) and Jack Daniel's Black Label Whiskey 1.75 L (\$13,579,015) were the top five items by dollar sales amount.

The largest dollar sales increases went to Fireball Cinnamon Whisky 750 mL (#59, +336.26%), Tito's Vodka 1.75 L (#63, +69.05%) and Wild Turkey American Honey Liqueur 750 mL (#41, +39.18%). The wines with the greatest dollar sales increases were Franzia Chardonnay 5L (#54, +36.58%), Apothic Red 750 mL (#93, +30.16%) and Elmo Pio Moscato 1.5 L (#80, +27.41%)⁹.

Unit sales in each region are displayed in tables 15 - 17. Four items appeared in the top 10 for all regions. These were Captain Morgan Original Spiced Rum 750 mL, Jack Daniel's Black Label Whiskey 750 mL, Nikolai Vodka 375 mL, Vladimir Vodka 1.75 L. When broken out, Captain Morgan Original Spiced Rum 750 mL sold the most in Region 2 (408,497) and was followed closely by its sales in Region 3 (408,421). Cavit Pinot Grigio 1.5 L in Region 1 (283,468) was the highest-selling wine.

Figure 6: On-Premise and Off-Premise Units Sold - Spirits Category, RY 2012 - 13





Figure 7 represents the proportion of on-premise and off-premise dollar sales. The proportion is roughly the same as the units.





Figure 9: Spirits Dollar Sales by Price Segment, RY 2012 - 13

Price segment performance is displayed in Figure 8 for units and Figure 9 for dollar sales. The standard, value and premium price segments have similar proportions of units sold. These segments are proportioned differently in terms of dollar sales. Premium (36.01%) is clearly the largest segment by dollar share, followed by standard (26.42%).

Figure 8: Spirits Units Sold by Price Segment, RY 2012 - 13





Figure 12: Imported and Domestic Table Wine, by Dollar Sales Amount, RY 2012 - 13





Figure 13: Imported and Domestic Table Wine by Units Sold, RY 2012 - 13

Figure 14: Wine Units Sold by Price Segment, RY 2012 - 13




Figure 15: Wine Dollars Sold by Price Segment, RY 2012 - 13


